The Agnes Turnbull Scholarship (first awarded in 1999) has been established to honour the memory of Agnes Turnbull who was a founding member of NZAWA (previously known as the New Zealand Airwomen’s Association). The scholarship is funded from the interest earned on the capital invested from the generous bequest made by Agnes Turnbull to NZAWA.

Purpose

. To assist a member in the achievement of practical and/or theoretical flight training. Can be used towards any of the following – flight training, examination fees, flight test costs or study fees.

Eligibility

- . Applicant must have a minimum of 50 hours flight time at date of application.
- . Applicant must be a permanent resident of New Zealand.
- . Applicant must be an Ordinary Member of NZAWA for two full years at date of application.

Method of Payment

. Scholarship monies will be paid on a dollar for dollar basis up to the value of the scholarship on presentation of invoices or validated receipts.

Conditions

- . Completed applications must be received by 1 March to be considered that year.
- . Scholarship monies must be utilised within 12 months of presentation and be used only for the purpose for which applied.
- . The recipient must provide a written report on their use of funds.
