VERY IMPORTANT

- We all understand the “*time to spare, go by air*” saying - therefore please communicate with your accommodation if you have a delayed arrival on Friday night, so that they know to hold your room for the weekend.

Edgewater Motel - 387 Hibiscus Coast Highway, Orewa, Auckland 0931 -

AIRCRAFT HIRE

We have confirmed a C172 and a R20160/Alpha160. These will be available to hire through the North Shore Aero Club. Hire rates will be published closer to the time.

FUEL

TRANSPORT – AUCKLAND AIRPORT ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Please note that if you are arriving via a commercial flight, Auckland Airport is approximately 45-50 minutes' drive from Orewa (and North Shore Airport) in light traffic. During rush hour this will become much longer. We have provided options for pick-up and drop-off to Auckland Airport. At this stage the following times will be adhered to:

On Friday 30th May: Pick up from Auckland Airport Domestic Terminal 1600 and 1800, dropping off at the preferred accommodation (Edgewater and Orewa Beach Holiday Park) or North Shore Aero Club.

On Monday 2nd June: Drop off at Auckland Airport Domestic Terminal, departing the preferred accommodation (Edgewater and Orewa Beach Holiday Park) in Orewa on Monday at 0830 and 1000.

We will do our best to accommodate travellers outside of these times and may endeavour to adjust the above times by approx. 30 min each way to meet number requirements. If on your registration form you indicate that you would like to be picked up or dropped off from Auckland Airport, someone from the North Shore team will be in touch.

TRANSPORT – DURING THE WEEKEND BETWEEN NORTH SHORE AND OREWA

North Shore Airport is approx. 15 minutes from Orewa. Shuttle (van) transport for the weekend, to and from North Shore Airport and the preferred accommodation (Edgewater and Orewa Beach Holiday Park) is available. Please make sure you select the option on your registration form.

There will be separate buses for both the Saturday night party and the Sunday night dinner, this is in addition to the above option, and you will need to make sure you select all three if you need transport for the whole weekend and both the Saturday and Sunday evening events.

You can select either of the Saturday night or Sunday night buses separately if you would like transport just for the evening events, or just one of the evening events.

Please send your trophies back as soon as possible (cleaned, polished and with your name engraved) in their appropriate packaging.



WEEKEND ITINERARY

FRIDAY 30th MAY 2025

NZAWA REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION DESK

The registration desk will be open from 1400 at the North Shore Aero Club, this will be upstairs in the clubrooms.

LIGHT AIRCRAFT PARKING

As the Rally is taking place in late autumn it is highly likely that all grass movement areas will be closed at North Shore, so parking will not be available on the grass. There is currently a small amount of parking available on the club side of the field, including a few gravel stands where picketing will be available. We are also working with North Shore's hangar owners to park visiting aircraft on the aprons in front of hangars, this will require aircraft to use chocks rather than tie downs in most cases.

The North Shore team will be in touch with you closer to the Rally date. If you indicate on your registration that you will be flying in, you will be allocated a parking spot, given detailed information on where this will be and what to do once you have parked.

NZAWA/NSAC FRIDAY EVENING BBQ

Kindly sponsored and hosted by the North Shore Aero Club. Starting at 1700, there is an informal welcome at the North Shore Aero Club. Catch up with old friends, meet new members and talk about the day's flying over a BBQ meal. NSAC bar will be open from 1700, and is able to take EFTPOS and credit cards.

SATURDAY 31st MAY 2025

COMPETITIONS

NZAWA registration and information desk will be open from 0730.

Judges' briefing at 0800. Transport for air judges and ground judges departs accommodation (Edgewater with a stop at Orewa Holiday Park) from 0730. **It is compulsory for all judges to attend.**

Competitor briefing at 0830. Transport for competitors departs accommodation (Edgewater with a stop at Orewa Beach Holiday Park) from 0800. This briefing will cover the weather, safety considerations, judges and competitors' various responsibilities, competition procedures, aircraft hire arrangements and any questions. **It is compulsory for all competitors to attend. The competitions start at 0900.**

FOOD

Morning and afternoon tea, and lunch will be available to those that have registered for it. Morning tea will be served at 1000, lunch from 1200 till 1300 and afternoon tea at 1500. Tea and coffee facilities will also be available.

ACTIVITIES

While we encourage people to compete, we understand that the whole day at the airfield can be a bit much for some. If you have your own transport and are interested in checking out local sights, here are some to visit:

- Auckland War Memorial Museum and Auckland Domain
- Auckland Art Museum
- Shakespeare Regional Park
- Check out the beaches on the North Shore – Long Bay, Browns Bay, Takapuna, Milford.
- Shopping at any of Auckland's malls – Westfield Albany, Westfield Newmarket, Commercial Bay, Manawa Bay.
- Kelly Tarlton's Aquarium
- Rainbows End
- The Zoo or MOTAT – or both, both are located at Western Springs.
- Auckland Viaduct – restaurants and bars, including Holey Moley for mini golf.

SATURDAY EVENING PARTY & DINNER

The party starts at 1800 at the North Shore Aero Club, dinner will be served from 1830. Dress in an **“OUT OF THIS WORLD”** theme! If you are looking for costume inspiration, check out the NZAWA January Newsletter.

Transport from the accommodation departs at 1730 from the Edgewater, stops at Orewa Beach Holiday Park at 1740, then continues on to North Shore. The bus will depart from North Shore at 2300 to return to the accommodation (stopping at the same two places).

This will be a 'walk and fork' style casual dinner so that people can mix and mingle. Tables will be available to sit down and eat, food will be served buffet style. NSAC bar will be open from 1700, and is able to take EFTPOS and credit cards.

To the male volunteers laden with garters, please bring your garters to the Saturday Night dinner as the Garter Ceremony will be held after dinner on Saturday night.

SUNDAY 1st JUNE 2025

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The NZAWA AGM will be held at the North Shore Aero Club at 0900. Transport will depart the accommodation (Edgewater with a stop at Orewa Beach Holiday Park) at approx. 0830. A group photograph will be taken after the AGM, followed by morning tea.

SUNDAY LUNCH

Sunday lunch will be available at the club for those that are not participating in the Sunday activities. Please make sure you register for this.

SUNDAY AFTERNOON ACTIVITIES

We plan to have two options available, as below, and in case the weather is not good for flying we have also lined up some guest speakers.

Both options below will depart at approx. 1100, aiming to return to North Shore at 1500. The lunch for both of the following options will be a 'cash lunch', more information will be provided closer to Rally dates.

OPTION 1: Controlled Aerodrome procedures at Whenuapai. Airways NZ and the NZ Defence Force have collaborated to provide this educational experience on operating safely in Controlled Airspace and at Controlled Aerodromes. This option will hopefully include an aircraft tour at Whenuapai (subject to availability and clearances).

OPTION 2: A scenic city flight around the Sky Tower, Rangitoto and Waiheke Islands and then lunch at Ardmore Airfield, with the opportunity to visit the Warbirds Hangars.

While we encourage you to get involved, if you would like a free afternoon that is also quite alright, a list of things to do around Auckland is available above under Saturday Activities.

NZAWA/GOFUEL AVIATION PRESENTATION DINNER

Transport from the accommodation departs at 1730 from the Edgewater, stops at Orewa Beach Holiday Park at 1740, then continues on to Wainui Golf Club. The bus will depart from the Wainui Golf Club at 2230 to return to the accommodation (stopping at the same two places).

MONDAY 2nd JUNE 2025

Depart on Monday when it suits you. Flight planning facilities are available at NSAC, please feel free to use the upstairs lounge and computers near reception.

Van transport to Auckland Airport, available as outlined in the transport section above. Van transport will also be available from the preferred accommodation (Edgewater and Orewa Beach Holiday Park) to North Shore Airport for those that have selected the option for the full weekend of transport.
